

## Alexander the Great, Greek or Roman Art & Architecture and Drama Activities



**Alexander the Great:** As students often find the military aspects of this topic challenging, this workshop will focus on key sieges and battles. Facilitators will go through maps, logistics, terrain, techniques and formations of the siege/battle.

**Greek or Roman Art & Architecture:** Two parallel sessions will be facilitated. Teachers can choose which one they would like to attend.

### Classroom Drama

**Activities:** This part of the workshop will focus on a range of activities which are useful for revision and can be used by students in all years. These activities are good fun, memorable for students and will enhance the students' learning and retention of prescribed material.



Participating teachers will leave with copies of gladiator and chariot racing games and two plays. Other activities will include "Splat" for learning vocabulary and terminology.

**Assessment Strategies:** Teachers will have the opportunity to explore and discuss aspects assessment in Classical Studies for the Junior Cycle. Facilitators and participants will have opportunities to share hints and tips around assessment. All teachers participating will leave with practical tips and resources.
