

# Ancient Greek for Beginners

This in-service is aimed at non- Ancient Greek teachers who would like to sample the Ancient Greek language.

Participating teachers will come away with resources and ideas that they could use for teaching an Ancient Greek module in their schools in either 1<sup>st</sup> Year or in Transition Year.

This in-service will also be linked in with the teaching of Junior Certificate and Leaving Certificate Classical Studies. The facilitator will draw from these courses and give examples of the Greek language as used by Homer, Socrates/Plato etc.
