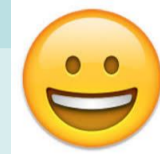

One Teaching, One Assisting

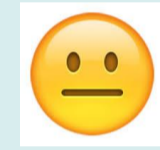
- Assisting role.

Benefits

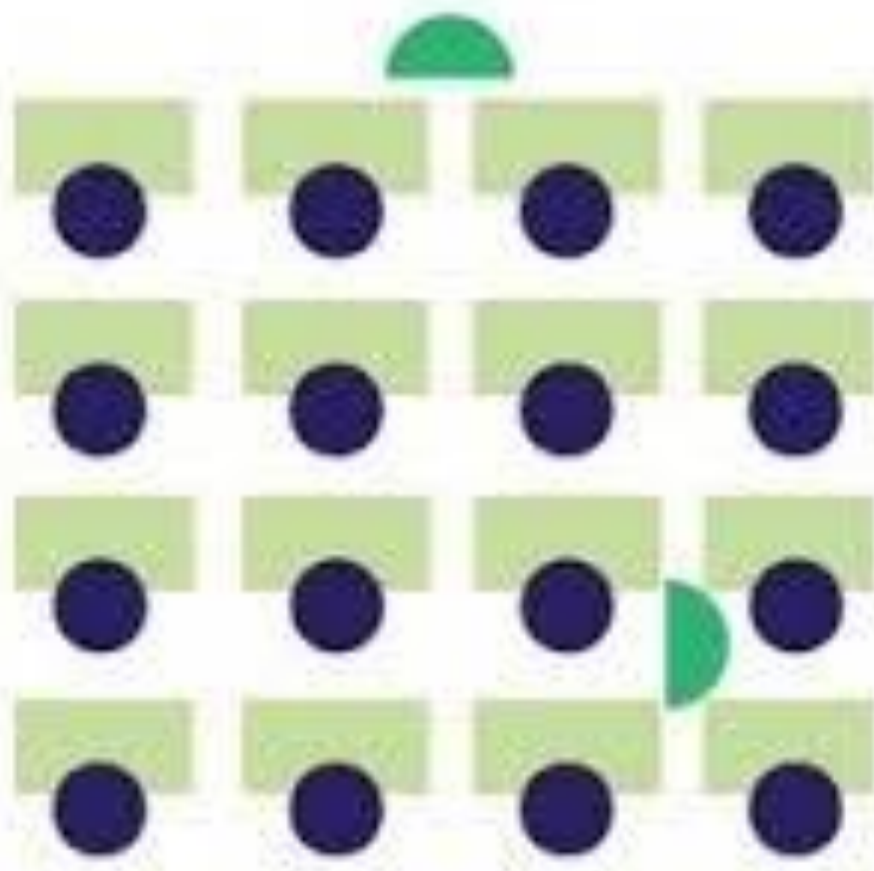
- Variety of resources, strategies implemented.
