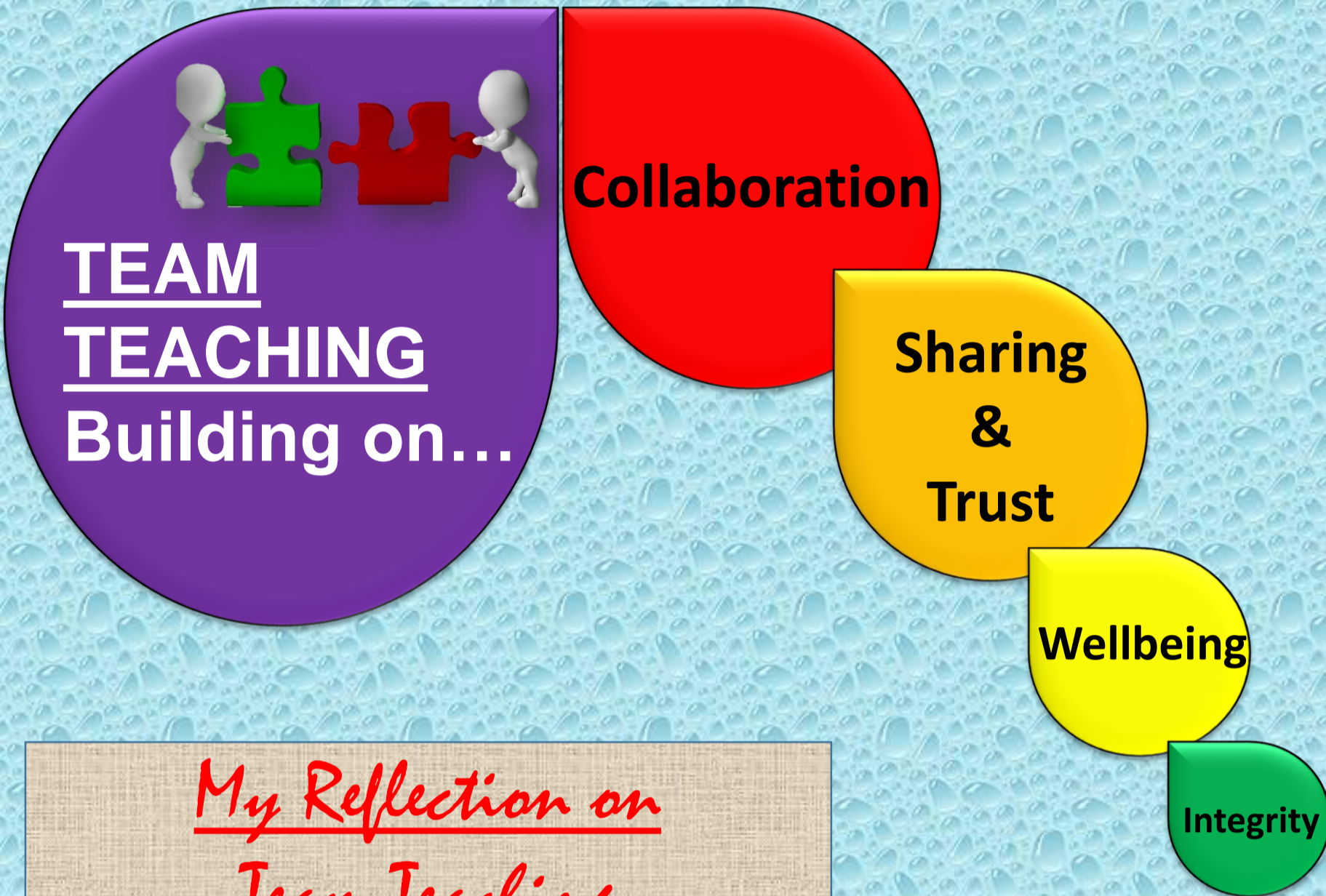


# Team Teaching CAN have a positive impact on Maths

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## Rewards of Team Teaching

➤ Team Teaching can be used as a methodology to facilitate inclusion in a mainstream classroom.

➤ Co-teaching allows more opportunities for small group and one-to-one learning, and stronger modelling during lessons.

➤ When students experience their teachers working together, they understand the power of respect amongst peers.
