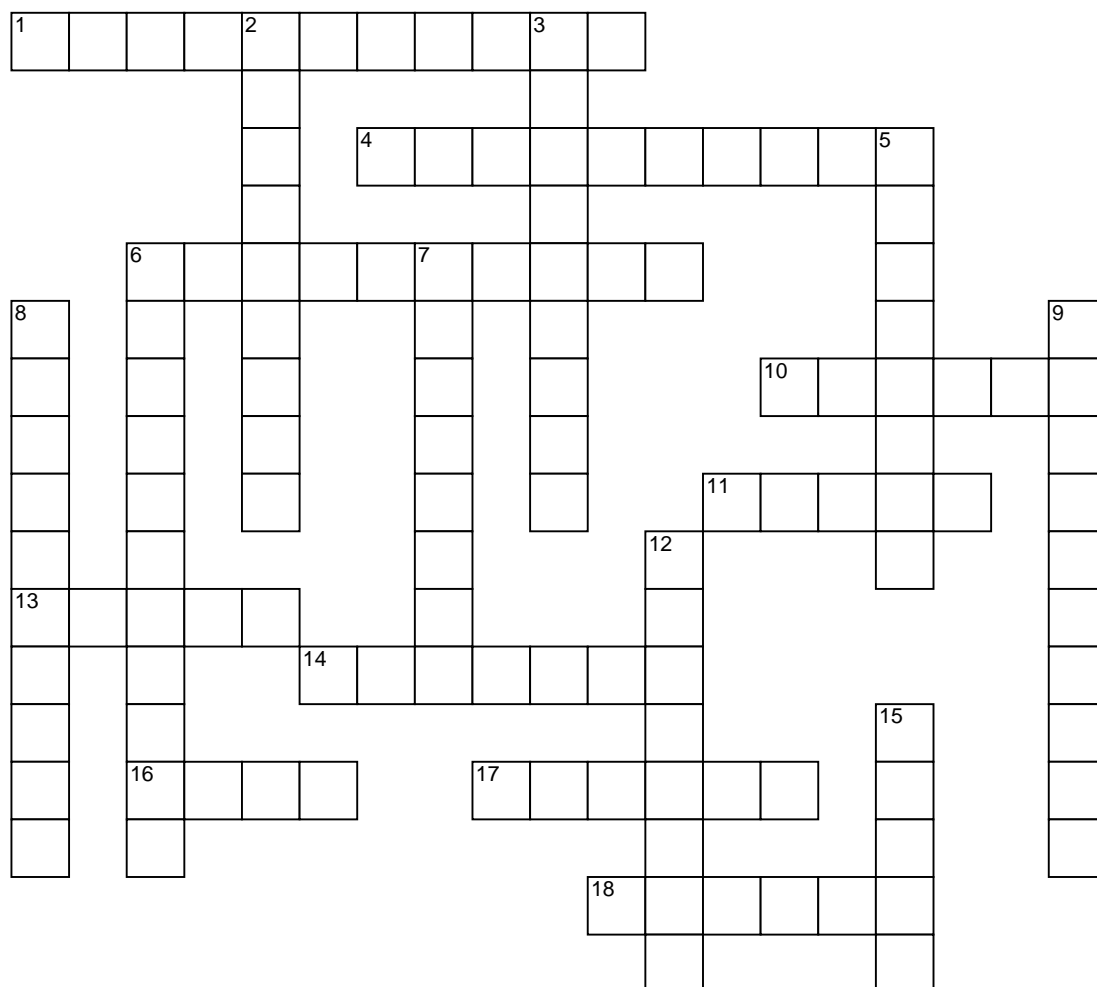


# The Stone Age

- 1 Name of famous dolmen in Co. Clare
- 4 The Middle Stone Age
- 6 Way of building with overlapping dry stones and no cement
- 10 The woven wooden structure of house walls
- 11 Type of stone used to make scrapers, arrowheads, etc.
- 13 A big pile of stones, often marking a tomb
- 14 New system of obtaining food rather than hunting and gathering
- 16 Name for plaster surface of walls
- 17 The roofs of houses were made of this
- 18 Another name for a portal tomb

- 2 Famous tomb in Co. Meath
- 3 The New Stone Age
- 5 The top stone on a dolmen
- 6 Place in north Mayo where there is evidence of early farmers (5,6)
- 7 Place in Co. Limerick where there is evidence of Stone Age farmers (5,3)
- 8 Type of tomb made of a mound of stones with an open area at the front (5,5)
- 9 Made of large stones
- 12 Opening over the doorway in Newgrange that lets sunshine into the chamber on the shortest days of the year (5,3)
- 15 Newgrange is built near this river
